Policy

Bluestone College has approval in place to deliver the qualifications from each awarding body in-line with Skills Funding Agency contracts along with learner demand. We have approval in place for awards with many awarding organisations. Approvals at any can be withdrawn if the centre is deemed to have acted in a manner that seriously compromises the quality of assessment. In some case a serious sanction may warrant the removal of approval for qualifications.

This following procedure is put in place:

- Where awards delivered by a subcontractor are withdrawn Bluestone College will ensure that Learners are transferred to a new training centre in order to complete their qualification
- In most situations the lead IQA will need to work with the awarding organisation in order to return award/centre approval with a full action plan in place.
- Where approval cannot be returned to the centre then will need negotiate the repatriation of learners to the Skills Funding Agency

If approval is withdrawn across all awarding organisations the director team will work with the Skills Funding agency to ensure that the learners are transferred to another training centre where they are able to complete their qualification

This policy is the responsibility of the company directors and the organisational head.
